

# **Go Figure : Improbable Bowling Analyses**

#### 19 for 90

Still unapproached after 59 years, Jim Laker's match figures in the Ashes test at Old Trafford in 1956 still defy belief. 9 for 37 in the first innings was followed by 10 for 53 in the second. Yes, it was a helpful pitch ... but it didn't seem to help Laker's combative spinning partner Tony Lock that much. He toiled away at the other end for 1 for 106 from 69 overs in the match.

## On this day (August 22<sup>nd</sup>)

On this day in 1992 at Colombo's Sinhalese Sports Club, Sri Lanka needed only 54 runs to win with eight wickets left to beat Australia. Offspinner Greg Matthews and fast bowler Craig McDermott took the next five wickets and brought the game to a head with Sri Lanka needing 31 more. Then a hitherto under-achieving legspinner, Shane Warne, took the last three wickets without conceeing a run and sealed a 16 run win for Australia. This was after Sri Lanka had taken a first-innings lead of 291, with Romesh Kaluwitharana flaying 132 not out on his test debut.


