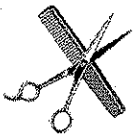

Nazar Mohammad made Pakistan's first test century, carrying his bat for 124 against India in October 1952. But his career came to a somewhat sticky end not long after that. According to a Pakistani newspaper, Nazar had been conducting an affair with a film actress, and had to make a hurried departure one day when her husband came home early. He jumped out of a window and badly broke his arm, and never played again.

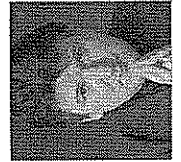

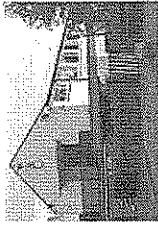

## You're Never Too Old

### The Oldest Test Debutant

James Southerton, a slow left-arter who played mostly for Surrey, was 49 at the time of the inaugural test match in Melbourne in 1876-77. Next on the list is the Pakistani offspinner Miran Bakish, who was 47 when he made his test debut in 1954-55.

## On this day (June 18<sup>th</sup>)

'The most embarrassing defeat in our sporting history' was how the *Sydney Daily Telegraph* summed up an Australian team performance on this day in 2005. Bangladesh had been 500 to 1 outsiders for their opening encounter in the Nat West Series, but having restricted a lacklustre opposition to 249 for 5, they set about scripting a miracle.

Led by the diminutive Mohammad Ashraful, who scored his maiden one-day century, they paced their run chase to perfection. With seven required from the final over, Aftab Ahmed walloped Jason Gillespie out towards the River Taff for a massive six. A scrambled single later, and the great upset had been completed.

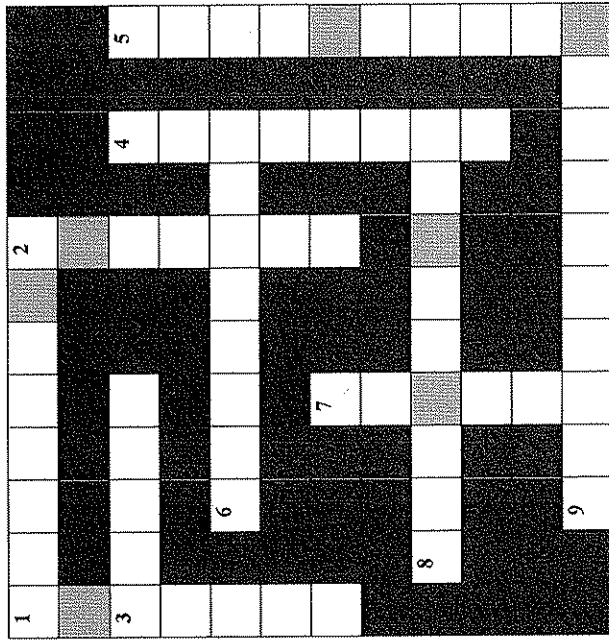
