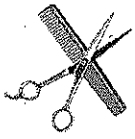

Mohammad Azharuddin scored centuries in his first three tests, and more than 15 years later made yet another in what was his 99th test, against South Africa in March 2000. But hopes for a century of caps were scuppered when he was implicated in a match-fixing scandal, and banned for life. The ban was lifted in 2012 after being ruled 'unsustainable' : but Azhar was nearly 50 by then.

When they failed to detonate, one terrorist advanced towards the crowd with a revolver. Though unarmed, Brett wrestled the gunman to the ground, and received the George Cross for his bravery.

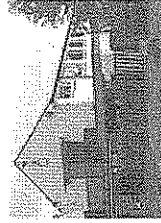

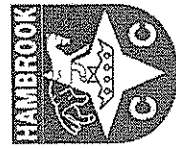

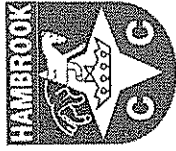

The Oldest Test hat-trick taker

The oldest bowler to take a test hat-trick was the Gloucestershire off-spinner Tom Goddard, who was 38 when he claimed three in three against South Africa in Johannesburg in 1938-39. The middle victim was Norman Gordon, the first test cricketer to make it to the age of 100 (he died in 2014, aged 103) Goddard's feat came late on Boxing Day in 1938.

On this day (July 23rd)

On this day in 1994 Mike Atherton put some dirt in his pocket and nearly lost his job. With England taking one hell of a beating against South Africa at Lord's, Atherton used the dirt to dry one side of the ball and so help Darren Gough to get some reverse swing.

Having dirt in his pocket was not illegal, but rubbing it into the ball contravened law 42.5, and the match referee called him to explain his actions. The referee accepted Atherton's explanation, but the following day Atherton admitted lying. For that he was fined £2000 and crucified by the press. Ray Illingworth said that the fines saved Atherton's job.

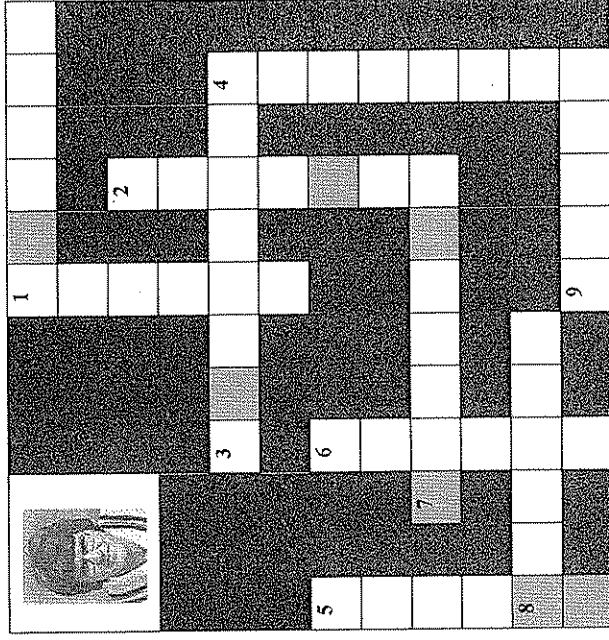
