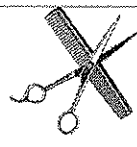

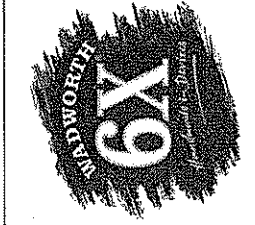

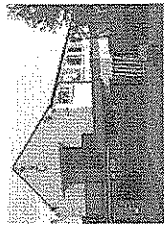
Curious Cricketers

Sir Douglas Bader (1910-1982)
1 first-class match : 66 runs @ 33.00
Bader was Britain's most famous fighter pilot, who won countless victories during the Battle of Britain and had a film, 'Reach for the Sky', made about him. Aged 21 and five months after the attacking batsman played his sole first-class match for the RAF at the Oval in 1931, he lost both legs when he crashed his plane.



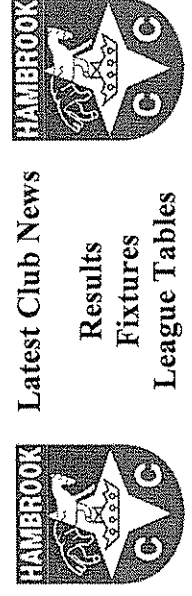

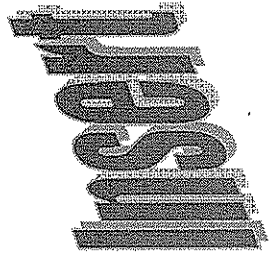

The Oldest Test Umpire

The oldest man known to have officiated in a test was the Australian Alfred Jones, who was three months short of his 70th birthday during the final match of the 1928-29 Ashes series, in Melbourne. That was Jones' seventh test, more than 25 years after his first.

The oldest in a one-day international is John Langridge, who was 69 when he stood in four matches during the 1979 World Cup.

This day in 1959 saw the birth of the talented but accident-prone wicketkeeper Bruce French.

He began by being bitten by a dog in the West Indies, then during a practice session in Pakistan he was hit on the head by a ball thrown back by a spectator.

As he walked across the hospital grounds to have his eyebrow stitched, he was knocked down by a car.

Then, when he woke up after an operation, he hit his head on the overhead light.

In the circumstances playing 16 tests for England was no mean feat.

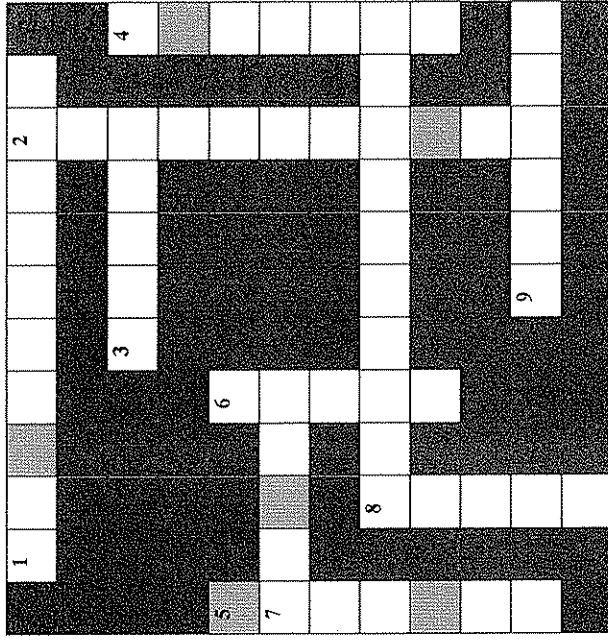
