Andy Sandham compiled test cricket's first triple-century against the West Indies in Kingston in April 1930. But that was a second string side, there was another England team playing tests in New Zealand at the same time. When Australia toured England later that year, England could not find a place for Sandham, and the Kingston test proved to be his last.

A dour batsman for Scotland, Clark was the biologist on Ernest Shackleton's ill-fated *Endurance* voyage. Aiming to make the first land crossing of the Antarctic, *Endurance* became stuck in the ice in early 1915 and the crew was not rescued until August 1916.

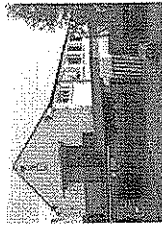

You're Never Too Old

The Oldest Test Bowler-Fielder Combination

We have to go back to Wilfred Rhodes for this one. His final test wicket, at the grand old age of 52, was the West Indian opener Clifford Roach in Kingston in 1929-30. And he was caught by George Gunn, who was over 50 himself. The aggregate of that fielding combination adds up to more than 103 years, and is going to be hard to beat.

On this day (August 27th)

This day in 1908 saw the birth of a boy christened Donald George, who went on to become the biggest name in the sport. Don Bradman's feats don't need much repeating: in his case: bare statistics are enough, culminating in an astounding test batting average of 99.94. He fell short of that figure in years, but not by much, when he died in February 2001.



This day in 1916 saw the birth of South African double international Tony Harris, whose test career was delayed by the second world war. Before it, he made his name as one of the great running fly halves in world rugby, masterminding the springboks famous series win in New Zealand in 1937.

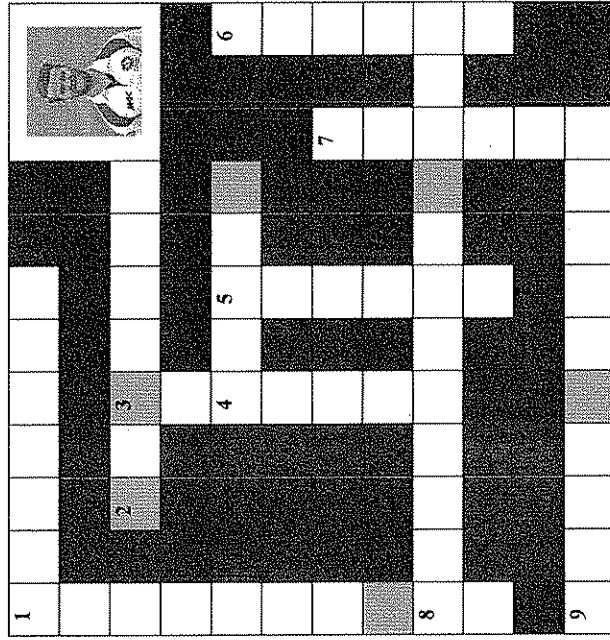
