









Ricardo Elcock

On the 1989-90 tour to the West Indies, aged 24, the Barbados born Middlesex quick bowler broke down with a stress fracture of the back. Two years later Elcock retired, and not knowing what to do, he spent his savings learning how to fly with the Antigua airline, Liat. Later he moved to Virgin Atlantic where he became the fleet's first black captain.

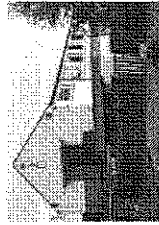

13 All Out - With Ten Extras

The women's World Cup qualifying match in Stellenbosch in February 2008 didn't last long. There were only three singles in the Bermuda innings, all by different batters, and seven ducks. If South Africa's bowlers hadn't conceded ten extras, it could have been really embarrassing. The hosts reached their target in four legal deliveries, as opening bowler Terry-Lynn Paynter added to the extras tally herself. In all, 20 of the matches 28 runs were extras. There were only five scoring shots in the match.

This day in 2012 saw Tino Best make what was at that point the highest score by a number 11 in tests, an entertaining 95 at Edgbaston. While Best missed a well-deserved hundred, his partner Denesh Ramdin got one – his first in three years. He celebrated it by taking a note out from his pocket that read, 'Yeah Viv talk nah', a response to Viv Richard's criticism of his batting. Ramdin, who later apologised for his gesture, was fined by the match authorities.

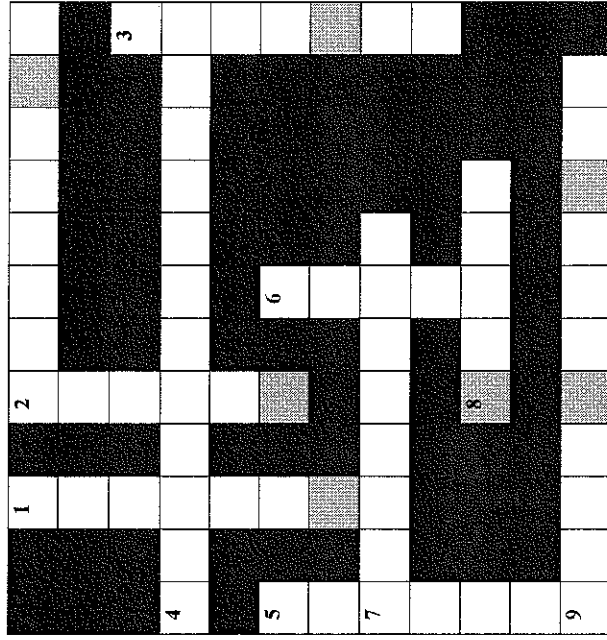
